

# FAVOURABLE GEOGRAPHICAL POSITION

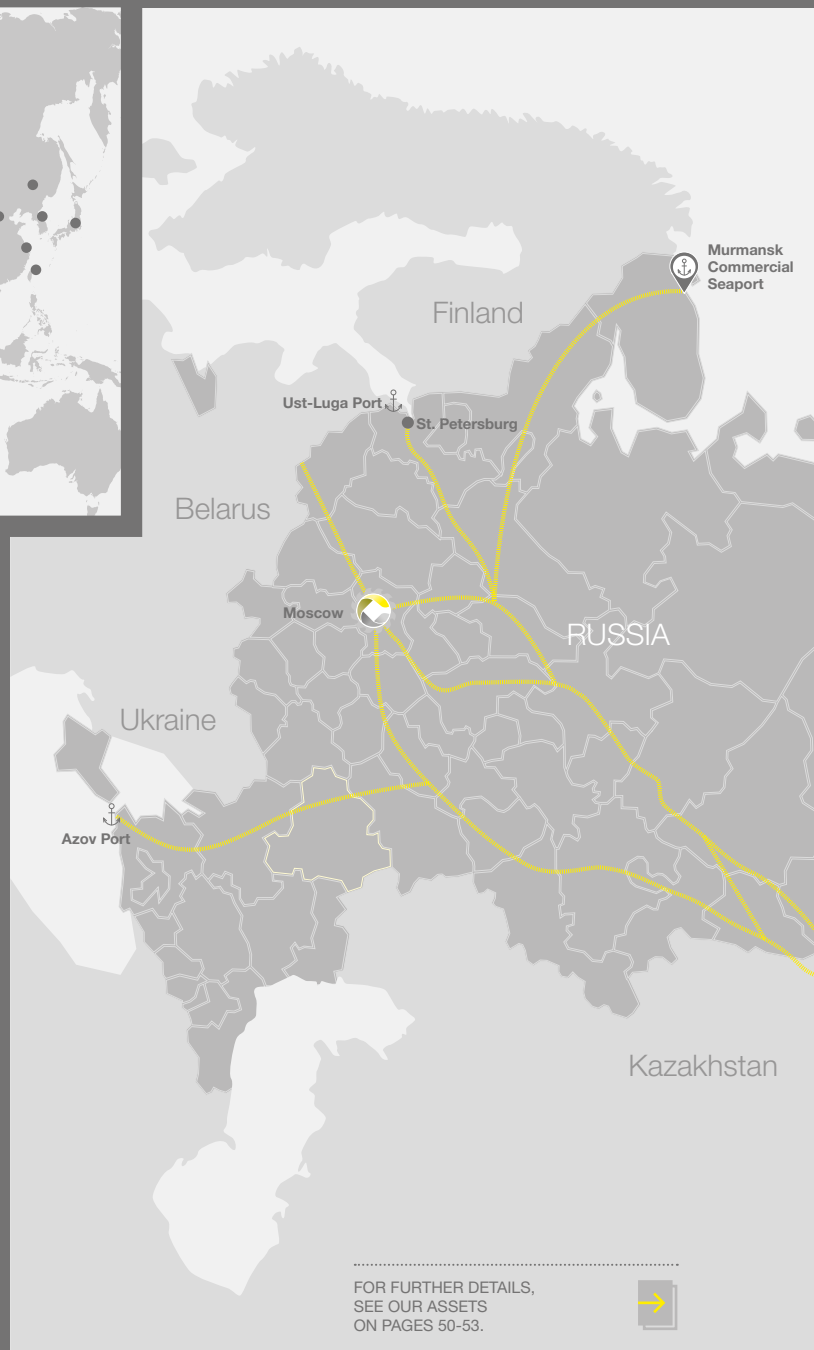
